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Week 4

This week we will look at personality. Your personality is the collection of traits that make you uniquely you. Let's look at some places the Bible shows God using personalities.

Day 1

1. Scripture

Read Genesis 39

2. Reflection

Based on verses 1-6, what kind of personality do you think Joseph had?

What do verses 7-9 tell us about Joseph's personality? How would you have reacted in a similar situation?

Do verses 22-23 confirm what you thought about Joseph's personality? Do you know the rest of the story? How does God use Joseph's personality to save not just Egypt, but the entire region, especially the people of God?

3. Prayer

Pray that God would begin to show you how your personality can be used in His kingdom.

Day 2

1. Scripture

Read Numbers 12

2. Reflection

What do these verses tell us about Moses' personality? What do you think meekness means?

Because of Moses' personality, how did God relate to him differently than the other prophets? How might our personalities influence the way we relate to God?

What does verse 13 reveal about Moses' personality? Are you so quick to forgive those who wrong you?

3. Prayer

Pray that God would reveal to you how He relates to your personality. Pray that you would grow closer as you learn to hear Him in the special way He speaks to you.

Day 3

1. Scripture

Read Luke 1:1-3, Acts 1:1-3, and Colossians 4:14

2. Reflection

What does Colossians 4:14 say was Luke's profession? What does this tell us about Luke?

Luke 1:1-3 and Acts 1:1-3 are some of the only verses written in classical Greek vs common Greek in the New Testament. Why do you think Luke used classical vs common Greek, and what does that tell us about him?

Luke's style of writing is like that of a historian. What does this tell us about Luke's personality, and how God used it?

3. Prayer

Pray that God would show you how your personality can be used to further His kingdom.

Day 4

1. Scripture

Read 2 Corinthians 10:1-13

2. Reflection

Paul is meek when speaking face to face with the Corinthians, yet bold by his letters. He looks at them as his children in the faith. What does this say about his personality?

What do you think of vs 10? Do you think Paul was physically unimposing? Do you think he was not a good speaker? What would these traits show us about his personality?

In these verses does it sound like Paul is full of pride? To whom does Paul give all the credit? To whom do you give the credit in your life?

3. Prayer

Pray that you would find a unique place in God's kingdom where your personality is a perfect fit.

Day 5

1. Scripture

Read John 18:1-27

2. Reflection

What does Peter do in verse 10? What do you think this says about Peter's personality? Given your own personality, what do you think you might have done in this situation?

In this chapter, Peter denies Jesus. What does this say about his personality? What do you think you would have done in this situation?

Read John 21:15-19. Here Peter is restored by Jesus following his denial. Peter would become a leader in the early church. What does this say about Peter's personality?

3. Prayer

Pray that you would be strong enough to overcome failures and go on to make an impact in God's kingdom.

Day 6

Review what you learned this week.

What is unique about your personality?

How does your personality fit into God's kingdom?
