

Trust in the Lord Who Rescues

Living in Babylon #3 – Pastor Gary Combs – February 18, 2018 – Daniel 3:1-30

How to trust in the Lord who is able to rescue:

1. Understand that _____ you to face a fiery trial.

John 16:33 (NLT) I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world."

1 Peter 4:12-14 (ESV) Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you. But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed. If you are insulted for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you.

1 Peter 1:6-7 (ESV) In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials, so that the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

2. Look for _____ in the midst of trials.

Isaiah 43:1-2 (ESV) ..."Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you.

Psalms 46:1 (ESV) God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

3. Believe that _____ to rescue you from every trial.

Psalms 22:4-5 (ESV) In you our fathers trusted; they trusted, and you delivered them. To you they cried and were rescued; in you they trusted and were not put to shame.

Psalms 34:19 (ESV) Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the Lord delivers him out of them all.

Galatians 1:4 (NLT) Jesus gave his life for our sins, just as God our Father planned, in order to rescue us from this evil world in which we live.

Colossians 1:13-14 (NLT) For he has rescued us from the kingdom of darkness and transferred us into the Kingdom of his dear Son, who purchased our freedom and forgave our sins.
