Living in Babylon #6 – Pastor Gary Combs – March 11, 2018 – Daniel 6:1-28

Daniel 6:1-28 (ESV) ...²⁵ Then King Darius wrote to all the peoples, nations, and languages that dwell in all the earth: "Peace be multiplied to you. ²⁶ I make a decree, that in all my royal dominion people are to tremble and fear before the God of Daniel, for he is the living God, enduring forever; his kingdom shall never be destroyed, and his dominion shall be to the end. ²⁷ He delivers and rescues; he works signs and wonders in heaven and on earth, he who has saved Daniel from the power of the lions." ²⁸ So this Daniel prospered during the reign of Darius and the reign of Cyrus the Persian.

1. He is the _____.

Acts 14:15 (ESV) ... we bring you good news, that you should turn from these vain things to a living God...

Psalms 90:2 (ESV) ... from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

Matthew 16:16 (NKJV) ... "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

1 Thessalonians 1:9-10 (ESV) ... you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.

2. He is the _____.

1 Timothy 1:17 (NLT) All honor and glory to God forever and ever! He is the eternal King, the unseen one who never dies; he alone is God. Amen.

Romans 8:3 (ESV) For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh.

Matthew 28:18-20 (ESV) Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me..."

Revelation 19:16 (ESV) On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written, King of kings and Lord of lords.

3. He is the _____.

Isaiah 43:11 (ESV) I, I am the Lord, and besides me there is no savior.

Isaiah 60:16 (ESV) ... you shall know that I, the Lord, am your Savior and your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob.

Hebrews 7:24-25 (NLT) But because Jesus lives forever, his priesthood lasts forever. Therefore he is able, once and forever, to save those who come to God through him. He lives forever to intercede with God on their behalf.
